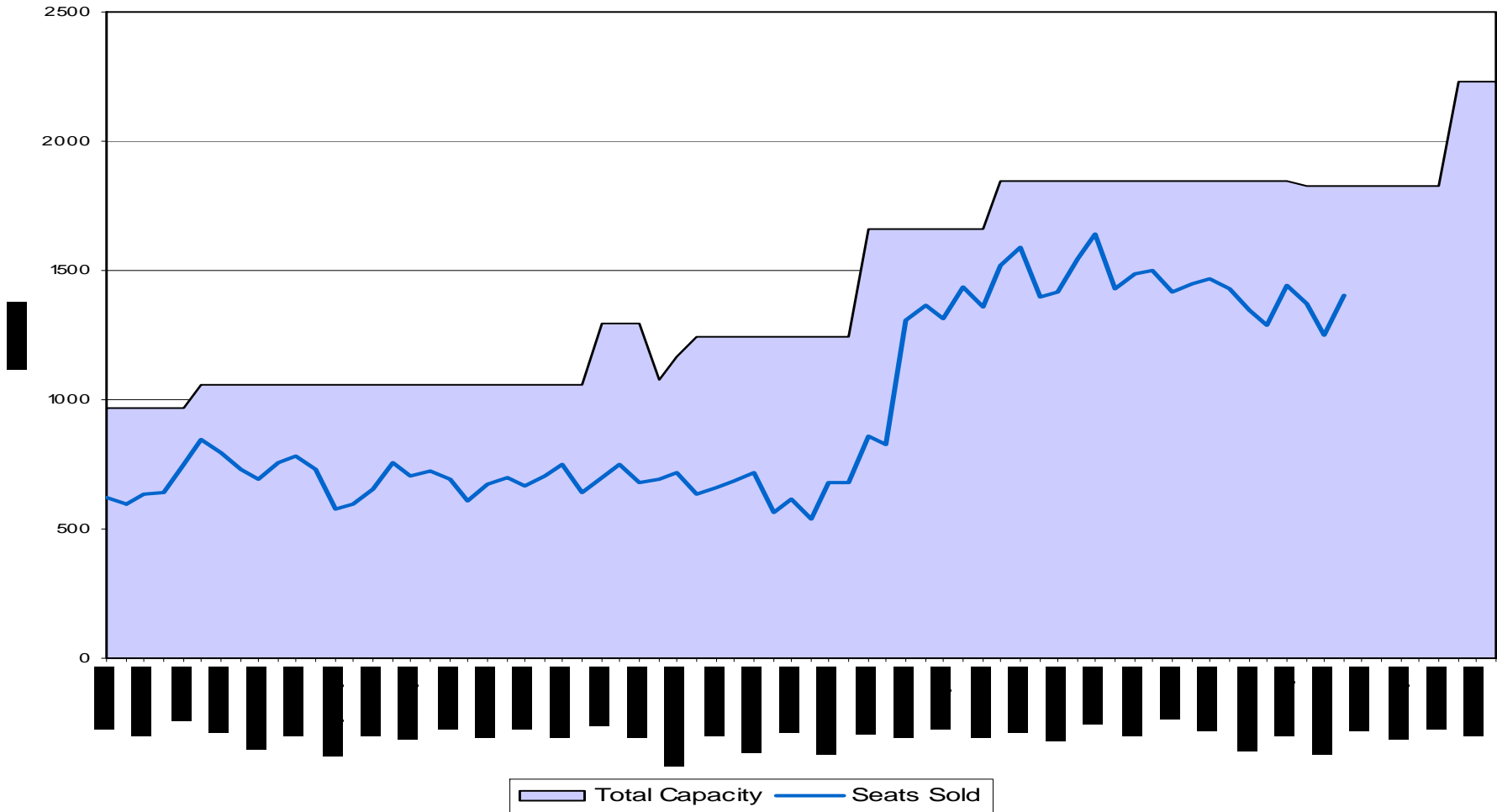

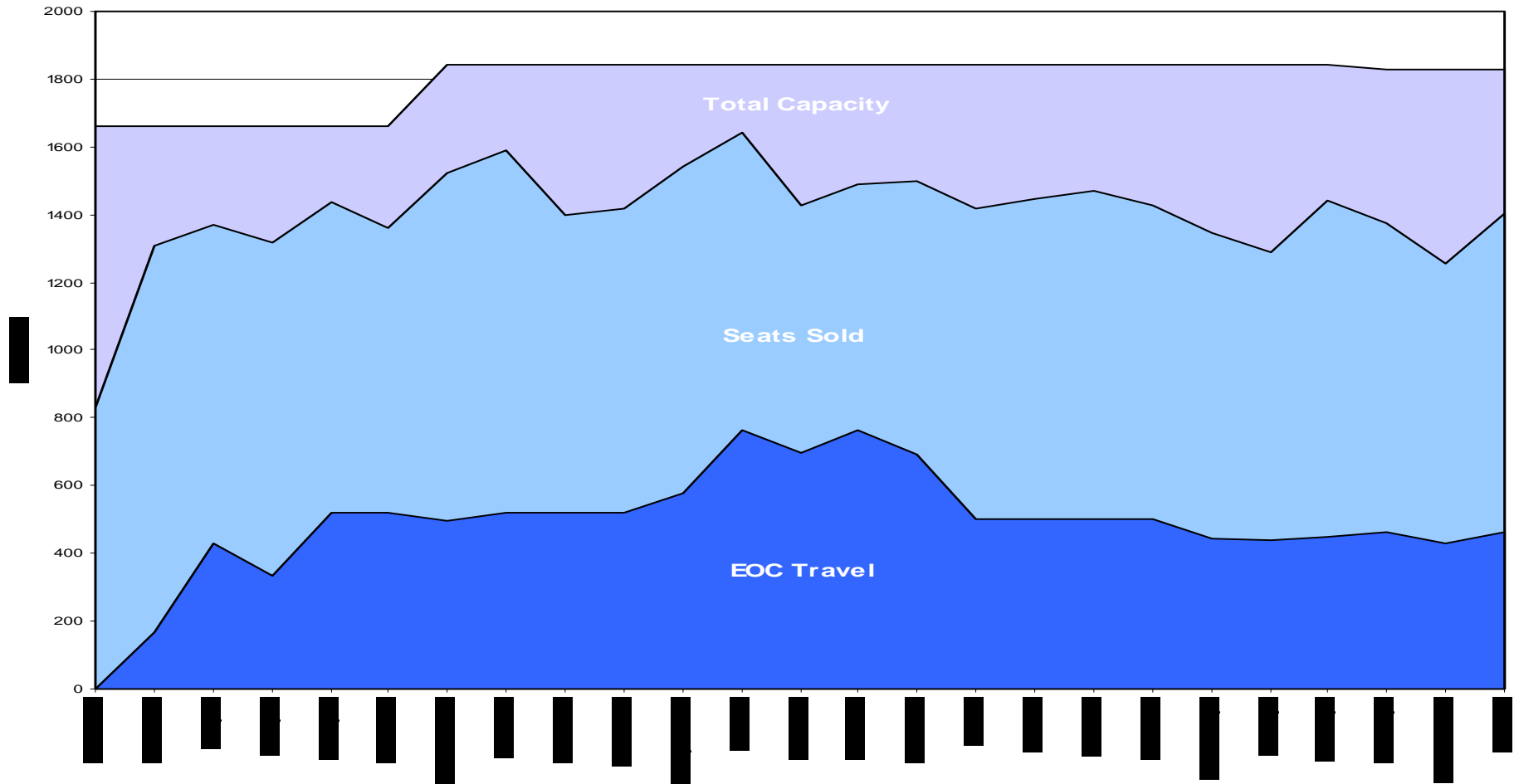
Learmonth Capacity

# *Skywest Flight Capacity to Learmonth*

- Passenger No.s have significantly increased since Mar 2007 when the EOC was formed
- Total seat capacity has always exceeded demand
- EOC travel is typically at a consistent base level with peaks associated to date with offshore drilling (June 2007)
- “D Check” on Fokker 100 placed it out of business for 3-4 months. Placed extra demand on existing fleet
- From Oct 15th 2007 two extra jet services each week on the Mon. & Frid. To be introduced to further stimulate tourism/recreational travel
